The second year of the
 Total Health project
 continued to achieve
 incredible outcomes for
 one community along the
 Amazon River, including:

- **50% REDUCTION** in the number
 of undernourished school-aged
 children
- Normal, non-anemic blood range
 levels **INCREASED FROM 22 TO 82%**
 in children 6 months - 5 years old
- Prevalence of parasites in
 children ages 1-12 **CUT IN HALF
 FROM 64 TO 32%**
- **94% OF PARTICIPANTS** learned how
 to effectively wash their hands
- **80% OF FAMILIES** with children
 under 5 installed home gardens
 to grow vegetables
- **50% OF PARENTS** attended positive
 parenting classes
